For the past 10 years, TSO creator Paul O'Neill and writers Robert Kinkel and Jon Oliva have been delivering the rock opera experience to arenas across the country. According to the TSO Web site, in O'Neill's experimentations, he attempted to "write music that was so melodic it didn't need lyrics...lyrics that were so poetic that they didn't need music." However, once he heard these pieces together, he could not imagine them apart. He fused the pieces together and realized that he had found the emotional impact he had been searching for; putting songs within the context of a story would provide the third dimension he so desired. This is when O'Neill began writing not just albums, but rock operas.
