

FREQUENTLY ASKED USHER QUESTIONS

WHAT IS AN UT EID AND WHY DO I NEED ONE?

The UT EID is an electronic identifier - your "user name" with The University of Texas. If you are associated with the university or if you need to complete online transactions with the university, you need a UT EID.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR THIS JOB?

We are accepting applications until Thursday, August 5 at 5:00 pm. You can download an application at www.uterwincenter.com/employment. Interviews will take place Thursday-Friday, August 12-13. If you pass the background checks and interviews, you will need to attend a paperwork session on Tuesday, August 24 or Wednesday, August 25 and a mandatory orientation Saturday, August 28. Times will be determined. The orientation should last approximately 2 hours. No back up dates are available.

Although background checks are being reviewed, you may be hired and attend the orientation. But, if your background check comes back negative, we will immediately remove you from the roster.

WHAT ARE AN USHER'S DUTIES?

During football games, ushers may tear/scan tickets, seat guests, answer guest questions and provide assistance to injured guests.

WHAT KIND OF EXPERIENCE DO I NEED?

None. We will train you for this job. Experience really means nothing to us as each stadium has its own policies and we are no different than any other stadium...except our ushers are better.

WHAT IS THE RATE OF PAY AND CAN I GET OVERTIME?

Starting rate of pay for an usher is \$8.00 an hour. Overtime is not an option.

WHEN ARE THE FOOTBALL GAMES SCHEDULED?

The home schedule is as follows:

WHAT DO I WEAR?

Usher attire is tan pants/shorts/skirts and clean tennis shoes. Shirts will be provided. Jeans and dirty tennis shoes or sandals are not permitted. Ushers will also need to carry a pen, paper and a small flashlight.

HOW LONG CAN I WORK?

You can stay on the payroll as long as you wish provided you work the minimum number of football games required. Some of our ushers have been on the roster for over 25 years and some work a semester and call it quits. It is up to you.

HOW DO YOU GET ASSIGNED TO AN EVENT?

We do not assign you. You come in and sign up for whatever you want to work. That is why this job is so good for working around your current schedule.
